



Walk a Block



Walking and cycling are active and convenient ways for your child to travel to school, but on the days you may need to drive, here are some things to consider:

Walk a block or two

On days when walking to and from school is not an option, consider parking a block or two away from the school drop off area and walk the rest of the way with your child. This reduces congestion near the school while also offering some physical activity. Learn more at everymetrecounts.ca

Carpool
